4. Shall obtain and have delivered to the site any culvert and/or drainage structures which may be necessary for drainage, the size, type and length as called for in this permit.
5. The owner is responsible for all damage occurring to public road way; any repairs must meet the satisfaction of the Road Commissioner or Municipal Officers of Damariscotta.

DISAPPROVED () REASON FOR DISAPPROVAL _____

Driveway culverts shall be a minimum of 15 inches diameter by 35 feet long in the ditch line where the driveway intersects a street. Culverts other than driveway culverts shall be determined on the basis of estimated runoff from the area served. All culverts shall conform to the State Department of Transportation Standard Specifications (Jan. 1984 or as may be amended) Section 603 Option III Pipe. All culvert pipe to be used shall be approved and inspected by the Town Road Commissioner prior to installation.

4.3.3 Driveway placement shall be such that an exiting vehicle has an unobstructed sight distance according to the following schedule:

Sight distance-The direct line of sight from a point four feet above the centerline of a road or highway to a point four feet above the center of the place at which vehicles enter and leave the highway
